

## klip

We spent the evening watching music *clips* on television.

**video**

### Correct usage of *clip*:

We watched a short *clip* from the film. (*krótki wycinek*)

Don't forget to *clip* your nails. (*obcinać*)

The boat surged ahead at a rapid *clip*. (*z dużą prędkością.*)

We spent the evening watching music **videos** on television.

## konfident

The police *confidant* provided crucial details about the crime.

**informant**

### Correct usage of *confidant*:

I only tell my closest *confidant* my terrible secrets. (*powiernik*)

The police **informant** provided crucial details about the crime.

## konsekwentnie

Ben has *consequently* produced good results for the company.

**consistently**

### Correct usage of *consequently*:

*Consequently*, we had to abandon our plans. (*w rezultacie*)

Ben has **consistently** produced good results for the company.

## konsekwentny

If you want to raise a child properly you must be *consequent*.

**consistent**

### Correct usage of *consequent*:

With the forest fire came the *consequent* destruction of wildlife. (*będący następstwem*)

If you want to raise a child properly you must be **consistent**.

**konserwanty**

I dislike American food because it is filled with *conservatives*.

***preservatives***

**Correct usage of *conservatives*:**

Political *conservatives* represent a strong force in America.

(*konserwatysty*)

My uncle George has *conservative* views on politics. (*konserwatywne* poglądy)

I dislike American food because it is filled with ***preservatives***.

**lunatyk**

Holy cow! She's walking in her sleep! She must be a *lunatic*!

***sleepwalker***

**Correct usage of *lunatic*:**

Oh! He has an axe and he's chasing the cat! He's a *lunatic*! (*wariat / szaleniec*)

Holy cow! She's walking in her sleep! She must be a ***sleepwalker***!

**manifestacja  
manifestować**

It was the largest *manifestation* Warsaw has ever seen.

***demonstration***

Sire, the people are *manifesting* in the streets!

***to demonstrate***

**Correct usage of *manifestation*:**

Lady Macbeth's sleepwalking was a *manifestation* of her secret guilt. (*przejaw*)

**Correct usage of *manifest*:**

A specter began to *manifest* itself in the attic of the haunted house. (*ukazywać się*)

It was the largest ***demonstration*** Warsaw has ever seen.  
Sire, the people are ***demonstrating*** in the streets!
